WEHS Raider Roundup Parade Regulations/Guidelines

1. All parade entries must enter the staging area by turning south on 1st Street from Brown Street. Parade entry check-in will take place at the northwest corner of 1st Street and Jefferson Street beginning at 5:15 p.m. All parade entries must arrive and be checked in no later than 5:45 p.m. to be placed in line.
2. All parade entries and participants must remain in their assigned order and travel the full length of the parade route.
3. Due to the safety of the parade spectators, nothing is permitted to be thrown from the parade float or participants. If your organization wishes to hand out anything (candy, flyers, etc.), you must walk along the parade route and hand-deliver the items to the spectators. However, this should not slow down the pace of the parade.
4. Upon completion of the parade route at the corner of Jackson Ave. and Oak St., all parade entries not directly associated with the WEHS Pep-Rally in Olde City Park must turn right onto N. Jackson Ave. to Jefferson St. to return to the original staging area. Do not unload until you are back to the original staging location, for this will disrupt the flow of traffic.
